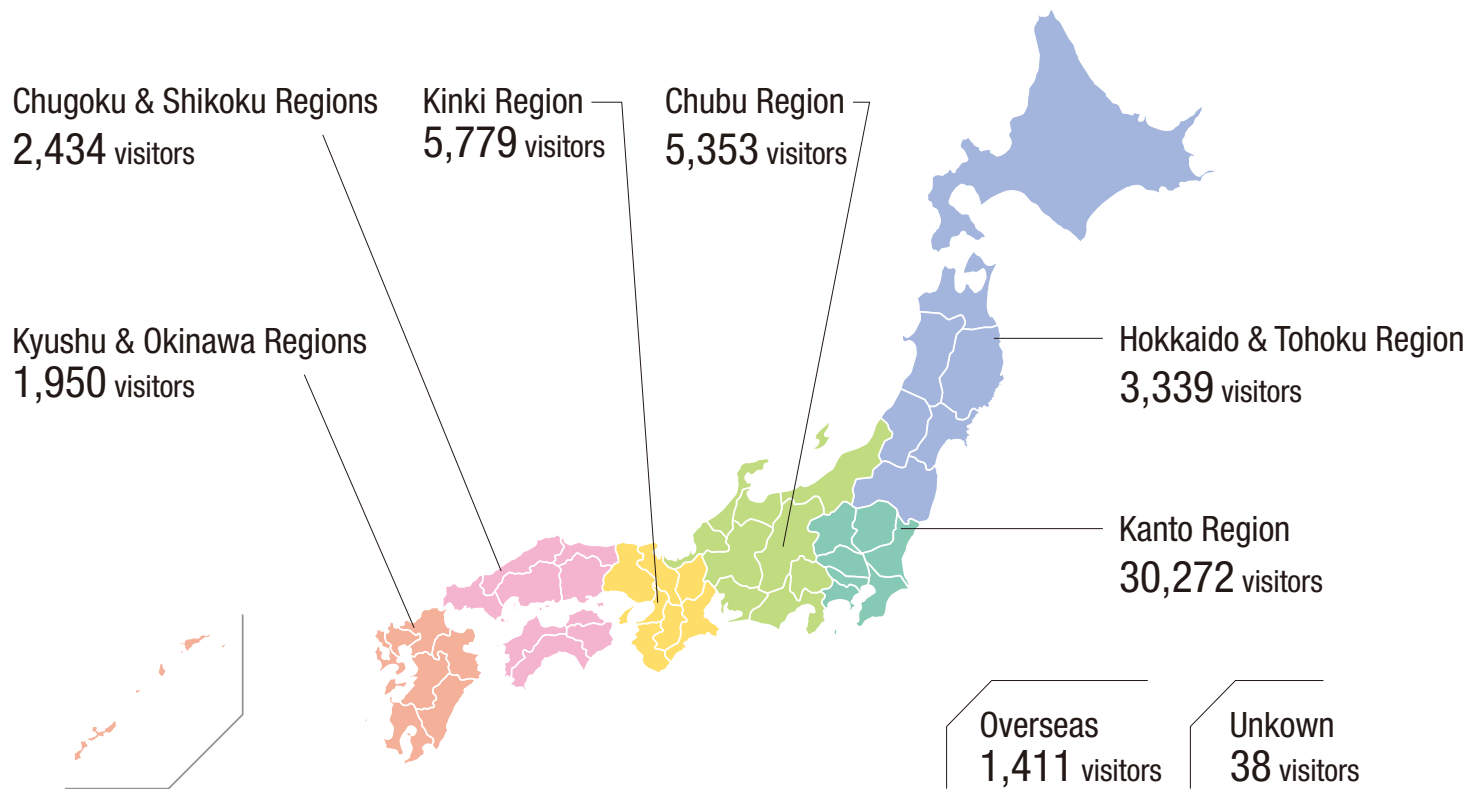

First-ever Saturday Exhibition Day

About the Saturday Exhibition Day

According to data indicating that approximately 80% of the construction and surveying industries are comprised of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), it is no exaggeration to say that these industries are fundamentally supported by SMEs. We frequently hear that many business owners and managers at these companies are out on-site throughout the weekdays, making it difficult for them to attend exhibitions held during the week.

The construction and surveying industries are currently facing an urgent challenge of labor shortages. As a result, there is a growing need to improve efficiency and reduce manpower through technological solutions. Given that SMEs form the foundation of these industries, the extent to which they are made aware of and adopt the products and services exhibited at this event will have a significant impact on the future of the entire sector.

Therefore, in order to create an environment that makes it easier for as many people as possible to attend, we have taken on a new challenge by hosting the exhibition on a Saturday for the first time.

Initiatives Taken for Saturday Exhibition Day

- Acquired nationwide contractor lists, promoted attendance by phone calls, and distributed invitations
- Ran TV commercials on BS channel
- Placed advertisements in various trade magazines
- Displayed video advertisements on a large screen at Kaihimmakuhari Station
- Sent invitations and made follow-up calls to supporting organization members and sponsors
- Sent invitations and made follow-up calls to past attendees



Preparing to Welcome General Visitors

While labor shortages are a challenge across nearly every industry in Japan, the issue is particularly acute in the construction and surveying sectors. Although the declining population is a major contributing factor, we, the Executive Committee, believe that the lack of information dissemination and promotion within the industry also plays a significant role. Due to insufficient communication about the industry's realities and appeal, the general public often forms negative impressions based only on surface-level perceptions.

In particular, the construction and surveying industries are prone to being judged by such superficial information. Many people associate construction as being “tough” or “an old industry” which is behind in time. However, in reality, cutting-edge technologies are increasingly being integrated into construction machinery and surveying equipment. The more we observe the industry, the more we recognize how rapidly it is advancing in terms of mechanization, efficiency, and labor-saving innovations.

We believe that it is also our responsibility, as the Executive Committee, to help share these realities more widely. As part of this effort, we have decided to open the exhibition to the general public to provide an opportunity for more people to learn accurate information about the industry.

For those who may consider working in the construction or surveying fields in the future, there is no better way to gain a true understanding than by seeing and experiencing the products and services presented by our exhibitors. Moreover, we believe that giving parents the opportunity to update their perceptions and correct any misunderstandings about the industry is a vital first step toward building a more appealing and well-understood field.

Efforts Toward Saturday Opening
